Quality: Showed a little improvement.

Demand: Improved demand at firm to little dearer rates following quality.

Buyers: Blenders were active. Loose Tea Traders lent only a fair support.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types sold readily at firm to little dearer rates. Medium were firm whilst plainer types were easier with some withdrawals.

Fannings: Clean bright liquoring types sold well at firm to little dearer rates. Mediums were steady whilst plainer types met with less demand and suffered fair withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Generally neglected. A limited weight sold at easier rates.

Dust: Clean good liquoring types were readily absorbed by the Blenders at firm to little dearer rates. Others were easier with some withdrawals.

Comment: Better liquoring teas witnessed an improved demand and sold at firm to dearer rates. Blenders were noticeably active and accounted for bulk of the teas sold. Plain and the poorer types continued to be neglected and where sold, were heavily discounted.
