LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: All well made good liquoring types were a strong market and generally sold at around last levels. Others sold well at mostly firm rates. Poorer types were neglected.

Fannings: Best types were readily absorbed at generally firm rates. Rests were a good market at around last levels. Poorer types were difficult of sale.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a fair demand at generally sold at around last levels. Prices ranged between Tk. 115/130. Better types however, fetched more. There were fair withdrawals in this category.
