<u>Fannings:</u> Best and below lent types sold well but at levels generally Tk. 5/10 below last. Others shed a little more. Plainer types suffered fair withdrawals.

<u>Bought-Leaf Teas:</u> Met with selective demand at generally easier levels than last. A fair weight however, remained unsold.

<u>Dust:</u> Met with a good demand. Prices for clean bright liquoring types were firm to occasionally slightly dearer. Rest were little easier. CD's were a strong feature especially the clean sorts.

<u>Comment:</u> Blenders operated actively especially for the clean bright liquoring types which however, eased in value. Others were also a good market at levels lower than last. Plainer types met with a limited demand. Dusts were a good market. There were some withdrawals in the later part of the sale.
