LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types sold readily at irregularly firm to generally slightly lower levels than last. Mediums met with a fair demand and sold at rates Tk. 3/5 easier than last. Plainer sorts witnessed limited interest and suffered fairly large withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and below best types sold well at mostly around at last levels. Mediums were firm to little easier. Plainer descriptions suffered fairly large withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with less demand and mostly remained unsold.
