Fannings: Best and below best types were a good market at levels mostly around last. Rest were firm to little easier following quality. Plain types were difficult of sale.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with selective interest from the Blenders at Tk. 160/= per kg. There were heavy withdrawals.
