Brokens: Well made good liquoring types were keenly sought after by all sections of the market and sold at firm rates. Select few popular well made types inclined following competition. Mediums were firm whilst plainer types were firm to irregularly little easier.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were a strong feature and ruled firm on last. Others mostly held on to last rates. Plainer types met with a fair demand at firm to little easier rates.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a little improved demand at levels mostly around last. There were however, substantial withdrawals.

Dust: Met with a good demand. Better liquoring types were generally firm whilst others were irregularly little easier. Cleaner CD's were a strong market whilst plainer types were easier and often neglected.

Comment: All sections of the market operated in strength which led to an improved demand this week. Prices were mostly firm with selective types tending dearer. Blenders were noticeably active and often competed for their share. Dusts sold well whilst cleaner CD's were a strong feature.
