## MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 17 HELD ON SEPTEMBER 02,2024

Leaf offerings consisted of 46,643 packages. There was a strong demand for the well made and good liquoring teas. Leaf withdrwals stood at 35% as against 45% in the last sale.


LEAF: There was a strong demand for the blackish and the well made teas but the high priced lines were little lower than last. Most others held its levels or occasionally gained. Northern teas met with large withdrawals and where sold, levels were between Tk.160/- to Tk.163/-. Selective best lines fetched between Tk.236/- to Tk.318/-.


Better fannings were in good demand at barely steady rates and often eased. Mediums were about firm. Plainer lines and the Northern teas met with some withdrawals. Northern fannings sold between Tk.160/- to Tk.170/-. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.238/- Tk.251/-.

<u>DUST</u>: 10,291 packages were on offer. There was a good demand. Better lines and the well made powdery types were firm to dearer. Others were about stady. Withdrawals stood at 30% as against 31% last week.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 3,324 packages were on offer. 42% sold and 58% remained unsold.
