**Brokens:** Well made good liquoring types sold well at rates firm to little easier than last. Mediums met with a fair demand but eased by upto Tk. 5/= from last. Plainer types eased about similarly and there were some withdrawals.

**Fannings:** Best and below best types sold readily at levels firm to Tk. 5/= easier than last. Mediums shed about similarly. Plainer types eased a little more and suffered some withdrawals.

**Bought-Leaf Teas:** Met with a selective demand at around last levels. There were again substantial withdrawals.
