LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well-made, good liquoring types were readily absorbed at mostly firm rates. Below best and mediums sold well at firm to little easier rates. Plainer sorts witnessed limited demand and suffered fair withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and below best types sold well at firm to occasionally easier rates. Mediums followed suit. Plainer descriptions suffered fairly large withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a fair demand at around last levels. There were however, fairly large withdrawals.
