Quality: Fairly useful.

Demand: Fairly strong demand at firm to little dearer rates.

Buyers: Blenders lent useful support. Loose Tea Traders were fairly active.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types met with a fairly strong demand and sold at firm to little dearer rates. Select few popular well made types gained more following competition. Mediums were firm. Plainer types met with a fair demand at around last levels.

Fannings: Clean bright liquoring types sold readily at about firm rates with occasional lines tending little lower with quality. Rest were about steady.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with selective demand at levels generally around last.
