

Tea Market Report

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 23 HELD ON OCTOBER 14,2024

52538 packages leaf were on offer in this sale. There was a good demand for the better teas at firm to occasionally dearer rates. Leaf withdrawals stood at 37% as against 43% last week.


LEAF: Good brokens were generally firm to little dearer. Mediums gained a little. Lower sorts met with large withdrawals. Northern brokens too met with large withdrawals and where sold ranged between Tk. 160/- to Tk. 183/-. Selective best lines fetched between Tk. 247/- to Tk. 350/-.

Cleaner well made fannings were firm to little dearer. Mediums inclined by Tk. Tk. 2/3. Poorer lines failed to attract any attention and generally remained unsold. Northern fannings mostly remained unsold and where sold, prices were between Tk. 160/- to Tk. 175/-. Selective best lines ranged between Tk. 240/- to Tk. 250/-.

DUST: 10,530 packages were on offer. Cleaner lines sold well as did the powdery lines. Withdrawals were limited to the lower fibrous teas. Dust withdrawals stood at 27% as against 35% last weeks.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 4,387 packages were on offer. 39% sold and 61% remained unsold.

The culture and preparation of tea

In North-East India the bush is formed as follows. About a year after planting it has grown into a conical plant 4 to 5 ft. high, which is then cut across flat in November or December, 18 in. above ground level and perhaps one center branch removed. The bush is allowed to grow up the following spring but is plucked, level with the ground, when it reaches about 30 in., and is kept plucked flat at that height. Next year or the year after it is again pruned back level to about 18 or 20 in. and in due course plucked flat again at 30in. Then each year or alternate year the bush is cut back, a little higher each time, on 1 in. or ½ in. of new wood. After twenty-five years or so, the bush may be getting too high for plucking, since this operation calls for a run of about 6 in. of new growth above the pruning level. In this event, the bush is medium pruned back to about 24 in., and the cycle of pruning started again. After a further fifteen to twenty-five years, total forty to fifty years from planting the area probably needs uprooting and replanting. However, many areas in Assam are at the age of sixty years still giving crops of 1,200 lb. tea per area.
