Brokens: Well made good liquoring types were readily absorbed at mostly firm rates. Occasional lines moved up slightly following competition. Below best and the mediums sold well at around last levels. Plainer types met with a fair demand at irregularly little easier rates.

<u>Fannings:</u> Met with a fairly strong demand. Clean bright liquoring types were generally firm to Tk. 5/= dearer whilst others were firm.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a little improved demand. Prices were generally firm on last. Select few better liquoring types fetched more.
