Quality: About maintained.

Demand: Fairly strong demand at generally firm rates.

Buyers: Blenders were active. Loose Tea Buyers lent a fair support.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well-made good liquoring types met with fairly strong demand, and prices generally held firm on last. Mediums met with fairly good demand at rates firm to little easier than last. Plainer sorts met with selective demand at little easier rates with some withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were a strong market and sold at around last levels. Others met with a good demand and sold at firm to easier rates than last. Plainer types met with selective interest at little easier rates and witnessed fair withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a fair demand. Better types sold well at levels generally around last. Others met with selective demand and suffered fairly large withdrawals.

Dust: Well-made bright liquoring types sold readily at firm to dearer rates following competition. Others generally held firm on last. Cleaner Dusts and CD's were a fairly strong market.

Comment: Demand continued to be fairly strong, especially for the brighter liquoring types, which often witnessed competition. Cleaner Dusts and CD's were a fairly strong feature and were well supported by all sections of the market. Blenders continued to operate in strength whilst Loose Tea Traders lent a fair support.
