

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 28 HELD ON NOVEMBER 18, 2024

Leaf offerings consisted of 53738 packages. Good teas continued to be firm. Plainer and the poorer types were mostly withdrawn.


LEAF: Good brokens sold at firm rates. Mediums occasionally gained by Tk. 1/2. Lower types did not receive much interest and were mostly withdrawn. Selective Northern brokens sold between Tk.160/- – Tk.190/-. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.243/- – Tk.289/-.

Cleaner good liquoring fannings were firm to dearer by Tk. 1/2. Mediums held its levels. Plainer fannings were easier and often remained unsold. Northern fannings sold between Tk.160/- – Tk.201/-. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.246/- – Tk.269/-.

<u>DUST</u>: 8,235 packages were offered for sale. There was a strong demand for the cleaner lines and these were firm to dearer. Others sold at around last rates.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 4,041 packages were on offer. 47% sold and 53% remained unsold.

<u>COMMENTS</u>: Market held firm for the well made teas and those with a good cup. Plainer and the Northern teas met with fair withdrawals. Packeteers were strong for the better teas. Crop upto the end of September shows a defecit of about 7.4m. kgs and is likely to increase much more with several estates closed due to the dearth of funds.
