MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 29 HELD ON NOVEMBER 25, 2024

48653 packages leaf were on offer for sale in sale no. 29. Market remained strong for the better teas. Prices were firm to dearer.

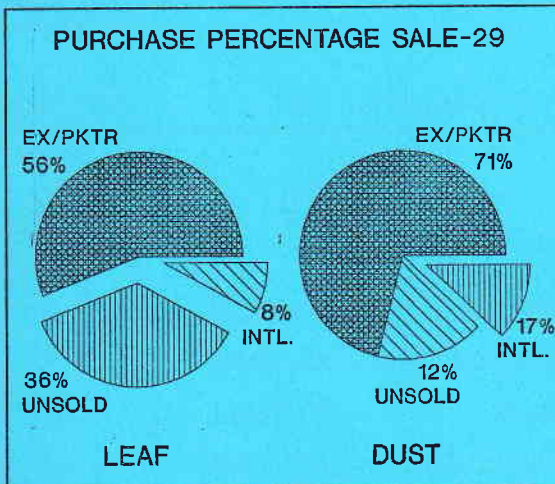
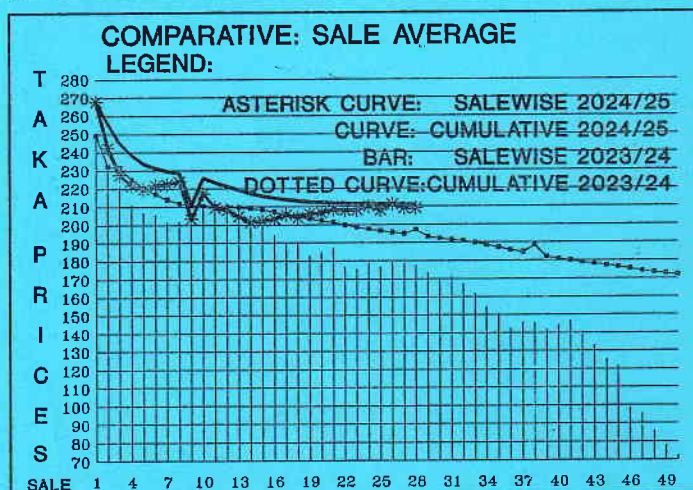
LEAF: Good and the medium brokens met with a strong demand and prices were fully firm to dearer by Tk. 2/3. Lower sorts met with fair withdrawals. Selective Northern brokens sold well and these generally fetched in-between Tk.160/- – Tk.196/-. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.246/- – Tk.275/-.

Well made fannings were fully firm and often appreciated by Tk. 2/3. Mediums also inclined. Plainer lines often remained unsold. Northern fannings sold between Tk.160/- – Tk.195/-. Selective best fannings fetched between Tk.245/- – Tk.280/-.

DUST: 7,339 packages were on offer. Prices held firm and often inclined with strong competition. Better lines and the powdery teas gained by Tk. 5/10.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 4,189 packages were on offer. 56% sold and 44% remained unsold.

COMMENTS: There was a strong demand for most well made and the good liquoring teas at firm to dearer rates. Northern teas met with a slightly improved demand. Dusts were a strong market and prices often appreciated sharply.

Total crop for Oct-Dec will most likely be much lower than last year and production up to the end of September is less by 7.4 million kgs.
