## MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 31 HELD ON DECEMBER 09, 2024

Leaf offerings comprised of 51033 packages. There was a good demand at easier rates. Leaf withdrawals stood at 43% as against 41% last week.


**LEAF:** Better brokens eased in value with prices declining by Tk. 5/7. Mediums were similarly easier. Well made Northern brokens sold between Tk.160/- – Tk.186/-. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.236/- – Tk.311/-.


Good fannings were an easier market as were the mediums as prices depreciated by Tk. 5/6. Plainer fannings met with fair withdrawals. Northern fannings generally sold between Tk.160/- – Tk.188/-. Selective best lines sold between Tk.235/- – Tk.270/-.

<u>DUST:</u> 9,181 packages were on offer. There was a good demand at lower rates than last. Dust withdrawals stood at 25% as against 18% last week.

**SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION:** 4,521 packages were on offer. 41% sold and 59% remained unsold.
