

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 32 HELD ON DECEMBER 17, 2024

There were 55,989 packages of leaf on offer. Demand was selective with fairly large withdrawals which stood at 50% against 43% last week.

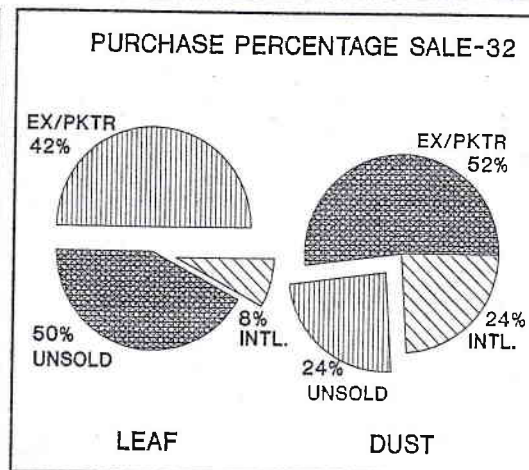
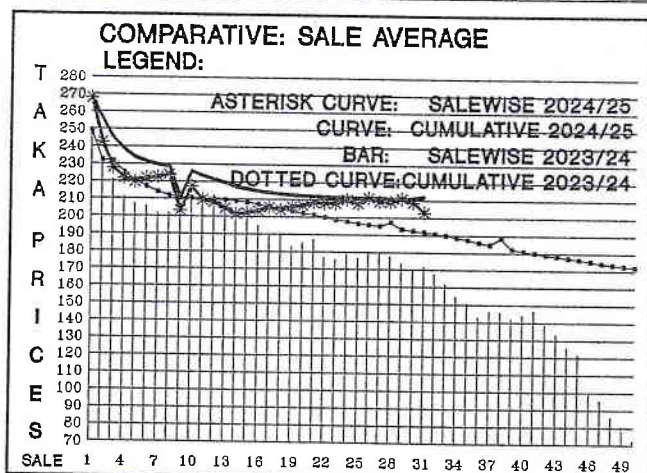
LEAF: Best and good broken teas eased Tk. 2/5 from last. Mediums declined a little more. Plain types and the northern teas were much easier and met substantial withdrawals. Selective best types sold between Tk. 255/- to Tk. 311/-.

Better fannings were sold at easier rates of Tk. 2/4. Mediums declined similarly. Plain and Northern fannings were sold easier considerably with a large quantity remaining unsold. Selective best lines fetched between Tk. 232/- to Tk. 295/-.

DUST: Offerings comprising of 9,342 packages met good demand at generally easier rates than last. Withdrawals stood at 24% against 25% last week.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 4,237 packages were on offer. 41% sold and 59% remained unsold.
