LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types sold well but eased by around Tk. 5/= from last. Bolder types were generally neglected. Others met with a fair demand at rates Tk. 5/7 easier than last. Plainer types were difficult of sale.

Fannings: A limited weight of the clean good liquoring types offered sold well but shed around Tk. 5/= from last. Others met with a fair market but shed Tk. 5/7 with some withdrawals. Plainer types were generally neglected.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a selective demand and suffered considerable withdrawals.
