**Buyers:** Blenders lent fairly good support. Loose Tea Traders were selective.

**LEAF-CTC:**

**Brokens:** A small weight of well made good liquoring types offered were well competed for by all sections of the market and sold at firm to dearer rates. Mediums mostly sold at around last levels. Plain and the poorer types were generally withdrawn without any bids.

**Fannings:** A limited weight of clean good liquoring types available met with a fairly strong market and sold at levels firm to dearer than last. Others were steady. Plain and the poorer types were difficult of sale.

**Bought-Leaf Teas:** Met with selective demand and where sold, prices were mostly around last.

**Dust:** Good demand for the brighter liquoring types which sold at firm to occasionally slightly dearer levels following quality. Plainer types were neglected. Cleaner CD's were a good market.

**Comment:** A small weight of the well made good liquoring types offered witnessed a strong demand and sold at premium rates. Others met with only a fair demand. Plain and re-printed teas were mostly neglected. Cleaner Dusts were a good market. Blenders and the Loose Tea Traders actively competed for the few well made good liquoring types on offer.
