Quality: Generally plain. There were however, a limited weight of well made good liquoring types on offer.

Demand: Strong demand for the well made good liquoring types. Other met with a limited demand.

Buyers: Blenders were active. Loose Tea Traders lent good support to the better types on offer.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: There was a strong demand for the well made good liquoring types on offer which ruled dearer than last. Below best types were firm. Mediums met with a fair demand at around last levels with the better sorts gaining slightly. Others were easier and suffered large withdrawals.

Fannings: Likewise, best and below best types were a strong market and often appreciated in value. Mediums were firm whilst plainer types were generally neglected.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with selective interest. There were heavy withdrawals.

<u>Dust:</u> Met with a good demand. Select few bright liquoring types sold well at firm to little dearer rates whilst others mostly held on to last levels. Plainer types remained unsold owing to lack of interest.

<u>Comment:</u> The limited weight of clean bright liquoring types available were a strong feature this week following active support from all sections of the market and generally appreciated in value. Plain and the poorer types continued to prove difficult of sale. Teas from the Northern District met with only selective interest.
