60,392 packages of leaf came under the hammer in sale 38. Well made teas remained in good demand. Others eased irregularly. Leaf withdrawals stood at 60% as opposed to 56% last week.

<u>LEAF</u>: Well made brokens were in good demand and were strongly competed for but at rates lower than last. Others were an easier market and met withdrawals. Northern brokens sold between Tk.160/- – Tk.165/-. Selective best lines sold between Tk.240/- – Tk.286/-.


Better fannings were similar and were in demand. Others generally declined and often remained unsold. Northern fannings sold between Tk.160/- – Tk.170/-. Selective best lines sold between Tk.233/- – Tk.256/-.


<u>DUST:</u> 11,448 packages were on offer. Better types were in demand. Powdery lines were well competed for. Dust withdrawals stood at 33% as opposed to 36% last sale.

OLD SEASON: Handful of old season teas sold between Tk.110/- - Tk.139/-.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 4,661 packages were on offer 49% sold and 51% remained unsold.
