**LEAF-CTC:**

**Brokens:** A small weight of the well made good liquoring types available met with keen competition and sold at firm to dearer rates. Others met with a fair demand and generally sold at around last levels. Plain types suffered heavy withdrawals owing to lack of interest.

**Fannings:** A handful of the best types offered sold readily at firm to dearer rates. Others met with only a fair market selling at firm to easier rates following quality. Plain types were neglected.

**Bought-Leaf Teas:** Limited demand with heavy withdrawals.

**Dust:** Met with an improved demand. Clean good liquoring types were a strong market and sold at firm to dearer rates, often substantially. Others were firm. Plain types were withdrawn without any bids. Cleaner CD's were a strong feature.

**Comment:** A small weight of the clean good liquoring varieties offered met with a strong demand and sold at higher rates. Rest were about firm. Plain and the poorer types were withdrawn without registering any bids.
