Brokens: A nominal weight of the clean good liquoring types available met with a good demand and sold at rates little lower than last. All others met with less demand at easier rates and a considerable weight remained unsold.

Fannings: Likewise, a handful of the best types offered sold readily at firm to little easier rates. Rest met with selective interest at easier rates and a substantial weight were withdrawn owing to lack of demand.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Selective demand with very heavy withdrawals.
