MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 40 HELD ON FEBRUARY 10, 2025

59,945 packages leaf were offered for sale. Small weight of good teas were firm. Few lines gained. Most others met with a restricted demand and withdrawals were large which stood at 66% as against 65% last week.

LEAF: Small quantity of good brokens sold at around last levels. Most others were generally neglected and met with substantial withdrawals. Selective best lines sold between Tk.237/- – Tk.270/-. Few lines of Northern brokens sold between Tk.160/- – Tk.165/-.


Limited weight of cleaner fannings with a good cup met with a satisfactory demand at around last levels. Plainer lines and the end of season teas were mostly neglected and remained unsold. Selective best lines fetched between Tk.235/- – Tk.269/-. Northern fannings sold between Tk.160/- – Tk.170/-.


<u>DUST:</u> 9,227 packages were on offer. There was a good demand. Cleaner dust and the powdery lines were about firm. Most others were easier than last. Dust withdrawals stood at 32% as against 34% last week.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 4,867 packages were on offer. 29% sold and 71% remained unsold.
