MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 41 HELD ON FEBRUARY 17, 2025

52,464 packages leaf were advertised for sale. Limited quantity of good teas sold well. Withdrawals were high stood at 67% as against 66% last week.


LEAF: Good brokens sold well at satisfactory rates. Others eased and mostly remained unsold. Selective best lines fetched between Tk. 235/- — Tk.249/-. Few lines of Northern brokens sold at Tk.160/-.


Cleaner fannings sold at about firm rates. Most others were easier than last with large withdrawals. Selective best lines sold between Tk.230/- – Tk.251/-. Negligible quantity of Northern fannings sold at Tk.160/-.


DUST: 8,372 packages were on offer for sale. There was a strong demand at mostly firm to dearer rates. Dust withdrawals stood at 34% as against 32% last week.

OLD SEASON: 322 packages were on offer and generally sold between Tk.131/-- Tk.134/-.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 5,324 packages were on offer. 23% sold and 77% remained unsold.







SALE NO: Sale 42 will be held on February 24, 2025 at 8:30 A.M. in Chattogram and will consist of 59,856 packages of leaf and 9,854 packages of dust.

OUR CATALOGUE: Sale no. 41 Avg. Tk.193.81, sold 28.11%.

COMMENTS: Better teas continued to sell well although there was a little slackness of demand towards close. Others were easier and a large volume of lower teas and the Northern teas remained unsold as demand for these were negligible.
