Quality: Generally poor and end season type. There were however, a small weight of well made good liquoring types on offer.

Demand: Good demand for the better types. Others met with a limited demand.

Buyers: Blenders as well as the Loose Tea Traders operated rather selectively.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A small weight of the brighter liquoring types available sold well at about firm rates occasionally easing slightly with quality. Others met with a fair demand. Plainer types were neglected.

Fannings: A limited weight of the clean good liquoring types offered sold readily at about firm rates. Others met with a fair demand at firm to little easier rates following quality. Plainer types were mostly withdrawn without any bids.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Only a limited demand.

<u>Dust:</u> Met with a fairly strong market especially the brighter liquoring sorts. Prices for these were generally firm to little dearer. Others were firm. Plain and the poorer types were neglected.

<u>Comment:</u> A small weight of the brighter liquoring types available were actively supported by all sections of the market and generally sold at around last levels. Mediums were about steady. Plain and poorer sorts failed to attract any interest and were neglected.
