MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 43 HELD ON MARCH 03, 2025

Leaf offerings stood at 43,595 packages. Small quantity of better teas were barely steady. Others met with a very weak demand and were mostly unsold. Leaf withdrawals stood at 70% as against 69% last week.


<u>LEAF:</u> Limited quantity of better teas were little lower than last. Poorer teas generally remained unsold. Selective best lines sold between Tk.223/- – Tk.255/-. Few lines of Northern brokens sold at Tk.160/-.


Negligible quantity of good fannings were a good market but little easier than last. Lower types eased or remained unsold. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.223/- - Tk.249/-. Few lines of Northern fannings sold at Tk.160/- and Tk.166/-.

<u>DUST:</u> 6,320 packages were on offer. Good dusts were firm to dearer. Powdery lines sold well. Lower types were mostly withdrawn. Dusts withdrawals stood at 49% as against 36% last week.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 3,964 packages were on offer. 20% sold and 80% remained unsold.
