**Quality:** Plain and end season type. A small weight of the brighter liquoring types were on offer.

**Demand:** Good demand for the brighter liquoring types. Others met with only a limited demand.

**Buyers:** Blenders lent fairly good support. Loose Tea Traders were selective.

**LEAF-CTC:**

**Brokens:** A small weight of the good liquoring types offered sold well but tended easier. Others met with selective demand at around last levels and there were heavy withdrawals.

**Fannings:** A limited weight of the better types on offer met with a good demand and sold at firm to little easier rates. Mediums met with a fair demand at around last levels. Plain types were neglected.

**Bought-Leaf Teas:** Met with selective demand and there were large withdrawals.

**Dust:** Well made bright liquoring types met with a good demand and sold at rates generally easier than last. Others met with selective demand and suffered large withdrawals.

**Comment:** This was the first sale of the holy month of Ramadhan. A small weight of the brighter liquoring types available were well supported by all sections of the market and sold at firm to little easier rates. Mediums met with selective interest. Withdrawals continue to be heavy especially in the plain and poorer category.
