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TEA MARKET REPORT – Sale 44 held on Monday 10th March, 2025

CTC LEAF: 50,538 packages of tea on offer met with a restricted demand.

BROKENS/FANNINGS: A select few clean liquoring types met with a good demand and sold at around last levels. Medium varieties received fair interest at mostly easier rates in line with quality. Plain and BLF teas were difficult of sale and withdrawals were very heavy.

DUST: 4,721 packages of tea on offer met with a fair demand. Only a few lines of good liquoring Dusts sold at steady rates. Remainder mostly reprinted, met with less demand at easier rates with several withdrawals. Blenders

lent good support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers. **COMMENTS:** Market continued to witness a restricted demand for the offerings which again comprised of end of season types. Blenders lent fair support but Loose tea buyers were again subdued. Dusts were an easier market.



DEMAND: - Continued Good demand. MARKET: - The total CTC leaf teas sold this week was 89.12 (1040079.18kgs) of the total offering of 1167068.20Kgs. BEST:- Modest quantity of larger broken on offer met with good demand at erratic price levels following quality. Other broken and the fanning grades continued to meet with good demand with prices being irregular and dearer on quality. Regional packagers continued to be active along with local buyers. GOOD:- Selective demand on this category and prices were irregular and easier. There were no fanning grade on offer in this category. Regional packagers, upcountry buyers were very selective and price sensitive. BETTER MEDIUM & MEDIUM :- This category saw a decline in demand with larger weight of teas remaining unsold due to want of bids. Few invoices sold were at irregular and easier prices. Select invoices on the fanning sold barely steady. Major blenders were very choosy and price sensitive this week with upcountry and local buyers being fairly active. Exporters were selective on the larger and medium broken. PLAINERS:- Fair demand with larger broken at steady prices. All other sorts in this category sold barely steady prices. Exporters we reactive on the larger and select medium broken. Major blenders and internal buyers were selective along with the upcountry buyers. BUYING PATTERN: - The major blenders off take was 35.64% of the total CTC leaf sold.
