<u>Dust:</u> A small weight of the clean good liquoring types on offer met with a good demand and sold at around last levels. Rest met with only a selective demand and generally remained unsold.

Bulk of the offering comprised plain, re-printed and end season type with failed to attract any interest and as a result, remained unsold. A small weight of the well made good liquoring types offered however, were keenly sought after by all sections of the market.
