LEAF-CTC:

Brokens/Fannings: A few lines of the cleaner types offered, mostly sold between Tk. 200/220 per kg. Others met with only a negligible interest and majority remained unsold.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Only a limited demand. Bulk of the offerings were withdrawn without any bids. However, a total of 770 bags of Bought Leaf Teas of New Season manufacture were offered which met with a fairly good demand and sold between Tk. 160/185 per kg.

New Season (2025/2026): A small weight of 300 bags of New Season manufacture were offered. These met with a fairly good demand and sold between Tk. 300/650 per kg. There were however, a few withdrawals.

New Season offerings met with a fair demand but fell short of Seller's expectation both in terms of price and demand.
