## MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 46 HELD ON MARCH 24, 2025

42,512 packages leaf came under the hammer in this sale. Very few lines of better teas sold well. Limited demand led to further decline in prices. There were substantial withdrawal which stood at 85% as opposed to 79% last sale.


**LEAF:** Very limited quantity of best and good teas were firm to slightly easier. All others were easier and large quantity remained unsold. Selective best lines sold between Tk.210/- – Tk.227/-. Few lines of Northern brokens sold at Tk.160/- – Tk.165/-.


Limited lines of better fannings sold well but at lower rates. Others remained easier with large volume remaining unsold. Selective best lines sold between Tk.210/- – Tk.220/-. Northern fannings sold at Tk. 160/- – Tk.165/-.

**NEW SEASON:** Handful of new season teas fetched attractive rates and sold between Tk.270/- – Tk.650/-. Northern new season teas sold between Tk. 160/- – Tk.190/-.

**<u>DUST</u>**: 2,431 packages were on offer. Small quantities of better teas and powdery lines sold well. Plainer and poorer types were mostly neglected.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 2,741 packages were on offer. 17% sold and 83% remained unsold.





<u>SALE NO:</u> Sale 47 will be held on April 7, 2025 Monday at 8:30 A.M. in Chattogram and will consist of 34,541 packages of leaf and 2,350 packages of dust.

OUR CATALOGUE: Sale no. 46 Avg: Tk.187.52, sold 18.75%.

<u>COMMENTS:</u> Better teas generally sold well. Others met with large withdrawals. Handful new season teas fetched attractive rates. Bulk of offerings were of poorer end season types, which were mostly neglected.
