29,178 packages leaf were on offer. Selective demand led to large withdrawals which stood at 77% as against to 85% last sale.

**LEAF:** Few lines of medium and plain brokens sold between Tk.160/- – Tk.185/-. Others remained unsold. Small quantity of Northern brokens sold between Tk.160/- – Tk.170/-. 3 lines of good brokens sold between Tk.200/- – Tk.215/-.

Limited quantity of fannings sold between Tk.160/- - Tk.180/-. Selective lines sold between Tk.200/- - Tk.210/-. Northern fannings sold between Tk.160/- - Tk.185/-.


