LEAF-CTC:

<u>Brokens/Fannings:</u> Met with selective demand mainly from the blenders. A large weight remained unsold.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Only a few lines sold at Tk. 160\= per kg.

New Season (2025/2026): A total of 3408 pkgs Leaf grades offered met with a good demand at levels mostly easier than last. Prices generally ranged between Tk. 220-330 following quality. Again, 3365 pkgs of B/L Teas offered sold well between Tk.160/200 following quality with some withdrawals.

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<u>Dust:</u> Poor demand. A few lines sold at Tk. 160/= per kg. Also, 1179 pkgs of New Season manufacture were on offer which sold well including 355 pkgs of B/L Teas. Prices were firm to little easier following quality.

<u>Comment:</u> Demand was mostly confined to the increased weight of New Season manufacture on offer which however, witnessed some decline in price from earlier sales. There were however, a few withdrawals. All re-printed teas met with a very selective demand and were mostly withdrawn without registering any bids.
