

# MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 44 HELD ON MARCH 09, 2026

11,452 packages leaf were on offer. Overall quality was mostly of end season. There was a satisfactory demand. Leaf withdrawals stood at 27% as against 20% last week.

**LEAF:** Limited quantity of well made brokens were about firm. Most others were an easier market. Poorly made teas met with some withdrawals. Selective best lines sold between Tk.274/- – Tk.285/-. Northern brokens generally sold between Tk.226/- – Tk.259/-.

A small quantity of good fannings were steady market. Others were mostly easier. Very poor lines failed to attract any attention and remained unsold. Selective best lines sold between Tk.272/- – Tk.285/-. Two lines of Northern fannings sold between Tk.248/- – Tk.252/-.

**DUST:** 2,744 packages were on offer. Good demand led to a satisfactory market. Few very poor lines remained unsold.

**Supplement:** 1,210 packages were an offer 50% sold and 50% remained unsold.

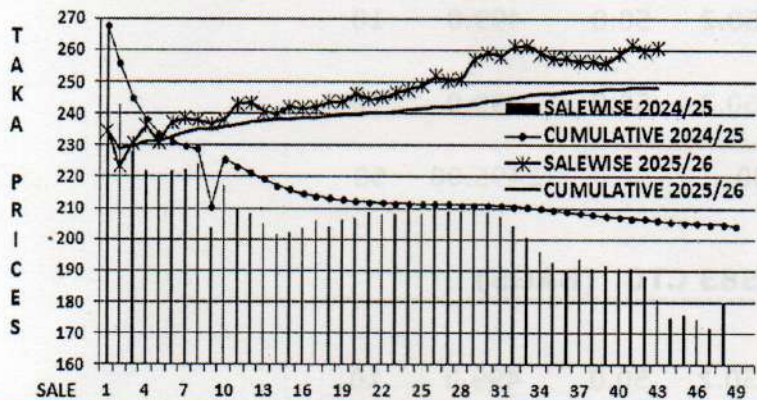

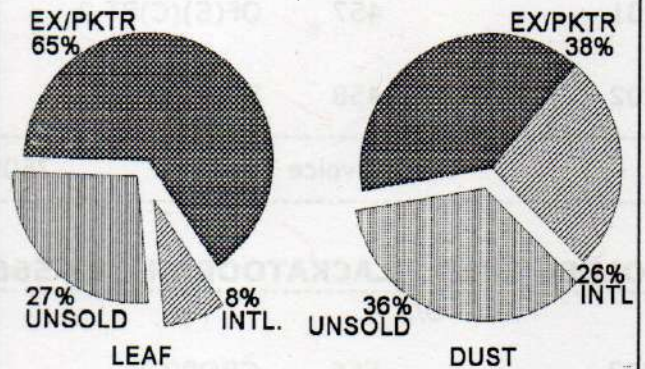
