

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 13 HELD ON AUGUST 04, 2025

32,545 packages of leaf were offered for sale. Prices eased as demand was lower than last. Leaf withdrawals stood at 30% as against 30% last week.

LEAF: All brokenes were a weaker market and prices eased by Tk. 5/10 or more for the higher priced lines. Selective best lines and some good clones sold between Tk.265/- – Tk.365/-. Northern brokenes generally sold between Tk.170/- – Tk.229/-.

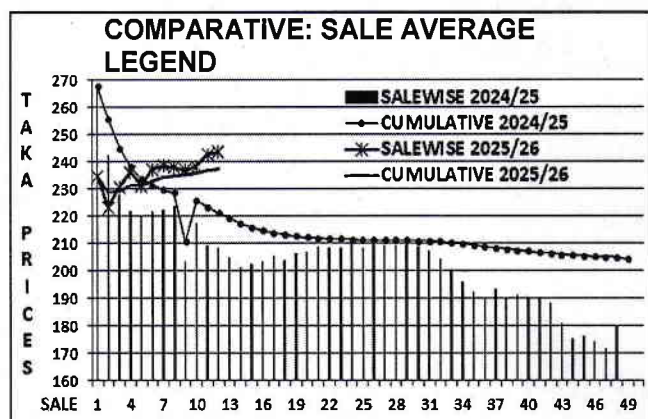
Fannings were generally an easier market with prices declining by Tk. 5/10. Selective best lines and few very good clones fetched between Tk.265/- – Tk.340/-. Northern fannings sold between Tk.170/- – Tk.228/-.

DUST: 7,536 packages were on offer. There was a good demand at reduced rates. Dust withdrawals stood at 32% as against 21% last weeks.

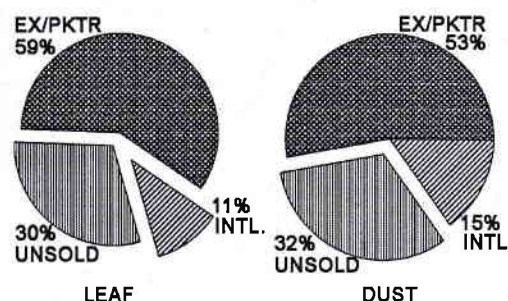
OLD SEASON: 1,214 packages were on offer. Few lines sold between Tk.160/- – Tk.185/-.
