

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 20 HELD ON SEPTEMBER 22, 2025

Leaf offerings comprised of 50,435 packages. Better teas were often dearer. Others were irregular. Leaf withdrawals stood at 39% as against 45% last week.

LEAF: Well-made brokenes were firm to occasionally dearer. Others sold at last week's levels. Lower sorts met with fair withdrawals. Selective best brokenes ranged between Tk.263/- – Tk.349/-. Northern brokenes eased and sold between Tk.195/- – Tk.224/-.

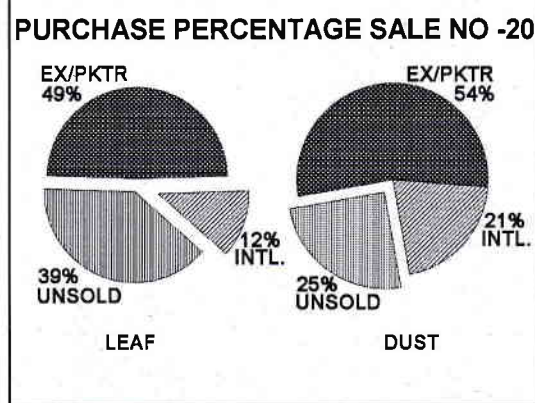
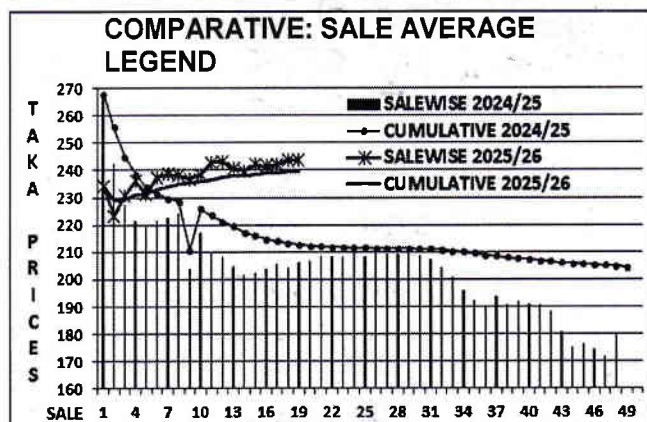
Good fannings were about firm. Medium sold at around last levels. Plainer types were mostly withdrawn. Selective best fannings sold between Tk.261/- – Tk.320/-. Northern fannings declined and sold between Tk.190/- – Tk.218/-.

DUST: 8,943 packages were on offer. There was a good demand. Cleaner lines often gained. Powdery teas sold at around last rates. Lower types remained unsold.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 3,993 packages were on offer. 35% sold and 65% remained unsold.

OLD SEASON: 535 packages were on offer and these sold between Tk.183/- – Tk.206/-.

COMMENTS: Better teas with a good make and useful brightish liquors often gained. Most others sold at around last levels. Lower types failed to attract attention and generally remained unsold. Packeteers were fairly active and shared freely. Local traders were little subdued in the leaf section but were more active for the dusts. North Bengal has witnessed a sharp decline in crop.
