
LEAF: Most well-made good brokens were generally a firm to dearer market. Mediums also inclined by Tk. 1/2. Lower types were again generally neglected and remained unsold. Selective best brokens and clones sold between Tk.271/- — Tk.354/-. Northern brokens ranged between Tk.200/- — Tk.245/-.


Cleaner well made fannings were well sought after at firm to dearer rates as levels generally inclined by Tk. 2/5. Mediums too gained by Tk.1/2. Plainer types met with fair withdrawals. Selective best lines sold between Tk.271/- — Tk.349/-. Northern fannings fetched between Tk.200/- — Tk.245/-.

<u>DUST:</u> 10,251 packages were on offer. Good liquoring and the cleaner dusts were firm to dearer as prices appreciated by Tk. 2/5. Powdery lines often gained more. Dusts withdrawals stood at 23% as against 21% last sale.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 3,401 packages were on offer. 36% sold and 64% remained unsold.
