

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 24 HELD ON OCTOBER 20, 2025

50,040 packages leaf were advertised for sale. Good teas continued to remain a strong market at firm to dearer rates. Leaf withdrawals stood at 34% as against 33% last week.

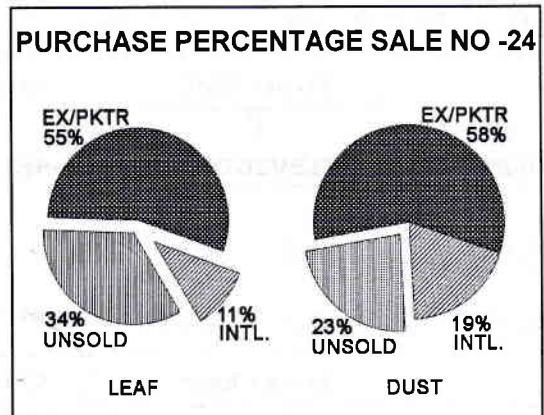
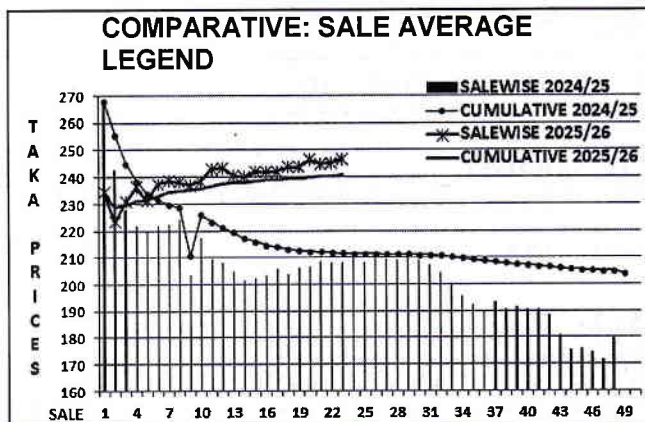
LEAF: Most well-made good brokenes were generally a firm to dearer market. Mediums also inclined by Tk. 1/2. Lower types were again generally neglected and remained unsold. Selective best brokenes and clones sold between Tk.271/- – Tk.354/-. Northern brokenes ranged between Tk.200/- – Tk.245/-.

Cleaner well made fannings were well sought after at firm to dearer rates as levels generally inclined by Tk. 2/5. Mediums too gained by Tk.1/2. Plainer types met with fair withdrawals. Selective best lines sold between Tk.271/- – Tk.349/-. Northern fannings fetched between Tk.200/- – Tk.245/-.

DUST: 10,251 packages were on offer. Good liquoring and the cleaner dusts were firm to dearer as prices appreciated by Tk. 2/5. Powdery lines often gained more. Dusts withdrawals stood at 23% as against 21% last sale.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 3,401 packages were on offer. 36% sold and 64% remained unsold.
