

## MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 26 HELD ON NOVEMBER 03, 2025

50,742 packages were advertised in this sale. There was a good opening demand when prices were firm to dearer but slackened as the sale moved forward. Leaf withdrawals stood at 37% as against 36% last week.

**LEAF:** Good brokenes were generally firm to dearer. Most others sold at around last rates. Plainer types met with fair withdrawals. Selective best brokenes ranged between Tk.271/- – Tk.371/-. Northern brokenes were a steady market and sold between Tk.200/- – Tk.241/-.

Cleaner fannings were generally firm. Few lines gained. Mediums were about firm. Lower types were mostly ignored. Selective best lines fetched between Tk.268/- – Tk.346/-. Northern fannings sold between Tk.215/- – Tk.242/-.

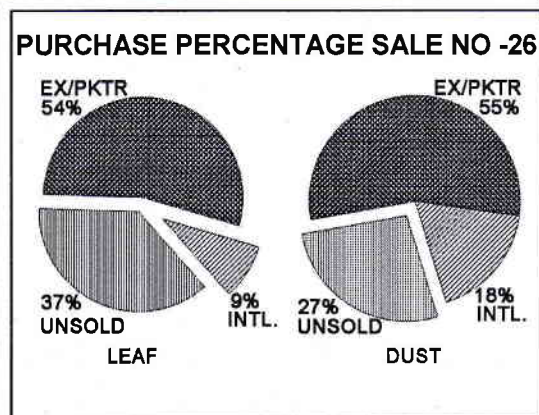
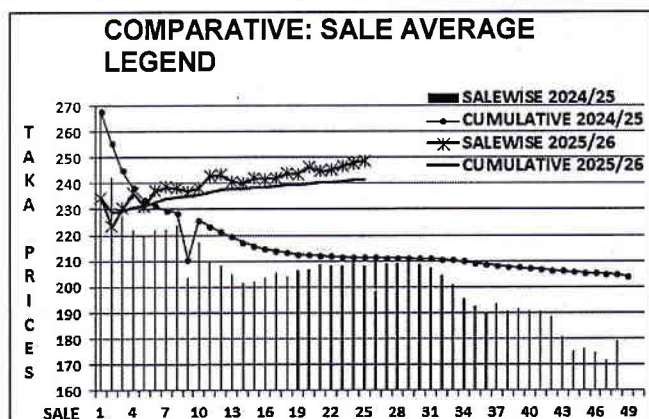
**DUST:** 10,025 packages were on offer. There was a strong demand for the cleaner lines at about firm rates. Fibrous lines depreciated or remained unsold. Dust withdrawals stood at 27% as against 15% last week.

**SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION:** 3,398 packages were on offer. 54% sold and 46% remained unsold.

**GREEN TEA:** 244 bags remained unsold.

**OLD SEASON:** A small quantity sold between Tk.191/- – Tk.227/-.
