

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 27 HELD ON NOVEMBER 10, 2025

47,850 packages leaf came under the hammer in this sale. There was a good demand at around last levels. Better teas were slightly dearer. Leaf withdrawals stood at 36% as against 37% last week.

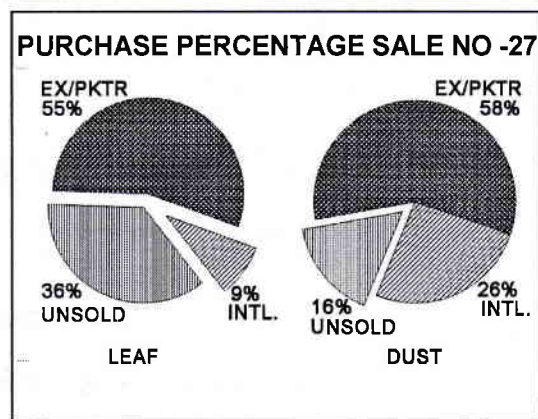
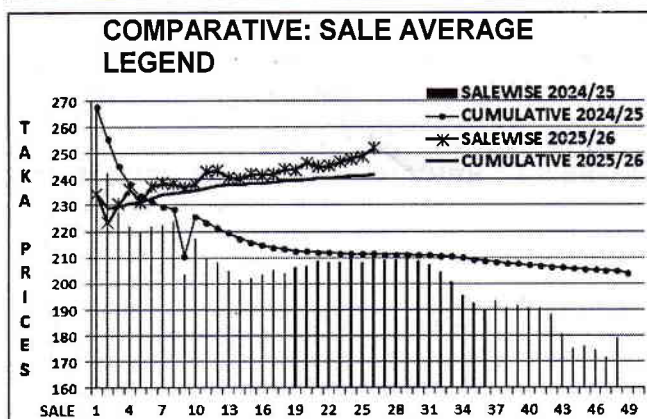
LEAF: Better brokens were firm to dearer by Tk.1/2. Mediums fetched about last rates. Lower sorts met with fair withdrawals. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.272/- – Tk.369/-. Northern brokens sold between Tk.210/- – Tk.239/-.

Cleaner fannings with a good cup often gained by a taka or two. Others were around last levels. Selective best lines sold between Tk.269/- – Tk.335/-. Northern fannings fetched between Tk.210/- – Tk.241/-

DUST: 8,689 packages were on offer. Strong demand led to a fully firm to often dearer rates of Tk.2/3. Powdery lines were strongly competed for.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 3,933 packages were on offer. 48% sold and 52% remained unsold.

COMMENTS: A fairly strong demand was witnessed in this sale with the packeteers being the main contenders. Local traders were also active for their requirements.

Overalls production figures of all producing companies are showing a constant decline. Lack of rains towards the end of the year, is being a major factor in the decline of quality too. Coming sales will witness a drop in quality/quantity with the post puja flush coming in for sale.
