

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 35 HELD ON JANUARY 05, 2026

47,256 packages leaf were up for sale in the first sale of the calendar year 2026. There was a fair demand but at reduced rates. Leaf withdrawals stood at 30% as against 23% last week.


LEAF: Good brokens met with a good demand at easier rates. Mediums sold similarly. Plainer sorts held its level. High priced teas were difficult to sell and met with fair withdrawals. Few lines sold between Tk.284/- – Tk.339/. Northern brokens ranged between Tk.227/- – Tk.253/-.

Cleaner and the medium fannings were an easier market. Plainer lines sold at around last rates. Best lines met with fair withdrawals and where sold, ranged between Tk.281/- – Tk.320/. Northern fannings sold between Tk.237/- – Tk.262/-.

DUST: 9,050 packages were on offer. There was a good demand but prices declined below last. Dust withdrawals stood at 20% as against 13% last week.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 2,596 packages were on offer. 46% sold and 54% remained unsold.
