

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 42 HELD ON FEBRUARY 23, 2026

20,970 packages leaf came under the hammer. There was a good demand but prices were easier than last. Leaf withdrawals stood at 35% as against 26% last week.

LEAF: Limited quantity of good brokens met with a good demand at lower rates than last. Others also eased in lines with quality. Lower types met with fair withdrawals. Selective best lines sold between Tk.276/- – Tk.323/-. Northern brokens sold between Tk.228/- – Tk.261/-.

Small quantity of clean well made fannings were easier. Mediums declined also. Very plain lines sold at around last prices but met with fair withdrawals. Selective best lines fetched between Tk.275/- – Tk.330/-. Northern fannings ranged between Tk.240/- – Tk.262/-.

DUST: 3,708 packages were offered for sale. Cleaner lines and the powdery sorts were well sought after at about firm rates. Dust withdrawals stood at 35% as against 34% last week.

Old Season: 340 packages offered sold between Tk. 227/- -Tk.245

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 1,827 packages were on offer.43% sold and 57% remained unsold.

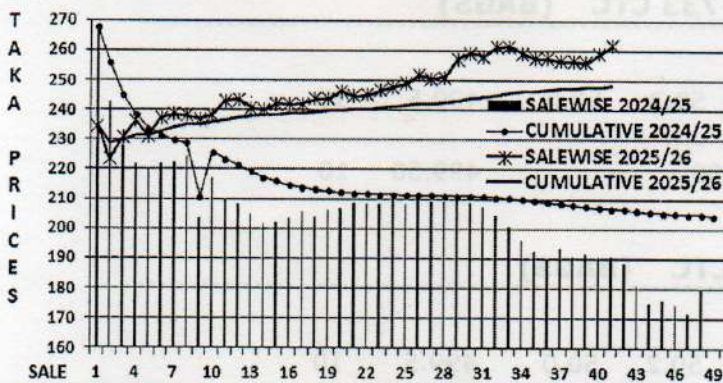

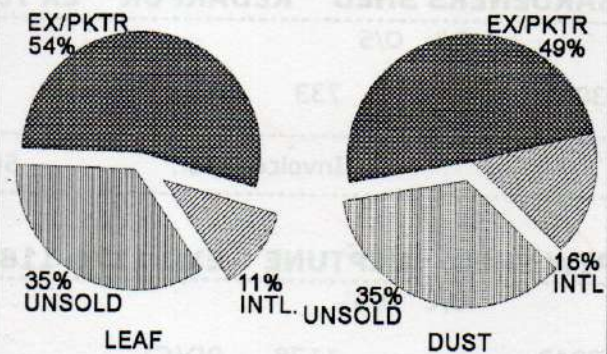
