LEAF-CTC:

Brokens/ Fannings: Well made good liquoring types were well competed for mainly by the Loose Tea Traders and sold at rates generally between Tk. 250/300 following quality. Select few best types moved higher. Mediums ranged between Tk. 205/230 and occasionally a little more.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a fairly strong demand especially the better liquoring types which mostly inclined in value.

Old Season Teas (2024/25): Generally neglected.
