## MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 01 HELD ON MAY 05, 2025

The opening sale of the season consisted of 11,624 packages of leaf. There was a strong demand for the offerings. Leaf withdrawals stood at 39%.

**LEAF:** Broken were a strong market particularly the blackish well made grainy lines. Selective best lines sold between Tk.281/- – Tk.391/-. Northern broken were in good demand and sold between Tk.160/- – Tk.209/-.



Good fannings were well sought after. Mediums also sold well. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.265/- – Tk.303/-. Northern fannings fetched between Tk.160/- – Tk.211/-.

**DUST:** 2,475 packages were on offer. Cleaner lines and the powdery dusts were in very strong demand. Dust withdrawals stood at 9%.

**OLD SEASON:** 4,801 packages were on offer. Only a handful of lines sold at Tk.160/-. Others remained unsold.

**SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION:** 1,497 packages were on offer. 37% sold and 63% remained unsold.

**SALE NO:** Sale 02 will be held on May 12, 2025 Monday at 8:30 A.M. in Chattogram and will consist of 22,239 packages of leaf and 2,796 packages of dust.

**OUR CATALOGUE:** Sale no. 01 Avg. Tk.249.76, sold 72.21%.

**COMMENTS:** The first sale of the season 2025/26 met with a fairly strong demand. Local traders operated strongly whilst the packeteers were more selective. Old season teas were mostly unsold as buyers showed no interest for those. Production level continues to remain low as the tea areas in Balisera and Luskerpore valley are still in a drought like situation.
