Brokens/ Fannings: Well made good liquoring types sold fairly well but prices mostly eased by Tk. 2/3 below last. Below best and the mediums were also an easier market and suffered some withdrawals. Plainer types were mostly neglected.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a good demand and mostly sold at around last levels.
