Dust: Met with a fair demand. Better liquoring types sold well but eased in value whilst others met with less interest and suffered fair withdrawals. Blenders were the major contenders.

Comment: Market opened on a firm note with the blenders absorbing the bulk of the offerings. Interest from the Loose Tea Traders were less. Demand eased towards close when buyers apparently fulfilled their requirements resulting in some withdrawals.
