MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 17 HELD ON SEPTEMBER 01, 2025

Offerings comprised of 50,239 packages of leaf. There was a good demand except for the plainer varieties, which met very limited interest. Leaf withdrawals stood at 39% against 42% last week.

LEAF: Well-made brokens with good liquors were firm to occasionally slightly dearer. Others were about firm. Selective best types fetched around Tk.266/- – Tk.357/-. Northern brokens were firm to dearer.


Best and good fannings met good demand at firm to little improved rates. Remainder were a firm market. Plainer types were difficult of sale. Selective best fannings sold between Tk.260/- – Tk.352/-. Northern fannings were fully firm to often dearer.


<u>DUST:</u> 11,448 packages were offered. Some good liquoring dust's were firm on last. CD's were generally easier. There were some withdrawals which stood at 37% as against 31% last week.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 4,745 packages were offer. 34% sold and 66% remained unsold.

<u>OLD SEASON:</u> There were 795 packages. Brokens sold between Tk.160/- – Tk.210/-. Fannings sold around Tk.170/- – Tk.213/-.

<u>COMMENTS:</u> Good liquoring teas met good demand from the packeteers with some support from the internal traders. Selective well-made types were picked by the internal buyers mostly. Plainer teas and those of indifferent make met large withdrawals due in part, for the minimum floor prices in place, whereas the old season teas sold fairly well. Northern teas met good demand at improved rates.
