<u>Dust:</u> Met with a little more demand than last. Clean, bright liquoring descriptions were readily absorbed at firm to occasionally little dearer rates following competition. Rest were firm to irregularly little easier and there were a few withdrawals.

<u>Comment:</u> Well made good liquoring varieties continued to draw active support at mostly around last levels. Conversely, plain and the reprinted teas met with less demand and suffered fairly large withdrawals. Dusts met with an improved demand.
