

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO 23 HELD ON OCTOBER 13, 2025

44,991 packages leaf came under the hammer. Strong demand led to a firm to dearer market. Leaf withdrawals stood at 33% as against 41% last week.

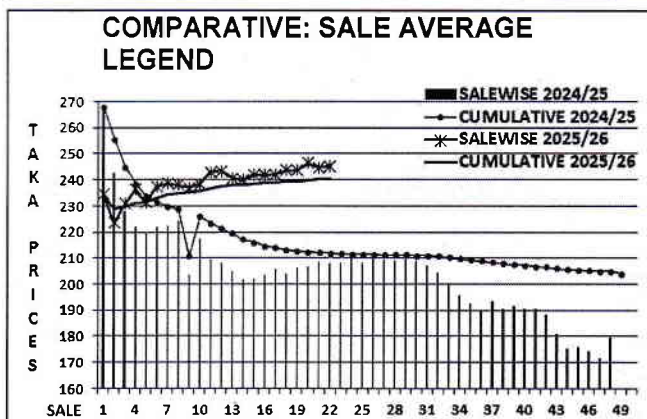
LEAF: Good and the below best brokens were well sought after at firm to dearer rates. Mediums gained a little. Plainer brokens met with fair withdrawals. Selective best brokens sold between Tk.269/- – Tk.336/-. Northern brokens ranged between Tk.198/- – Tk.245/-.

Good fannings were a dearer market. Mediums inclined by Tk.1/2. Lower sorts were mostly neglected and remained unsold. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.269/- – Tk.360/-. Northern fannings fetched between Tk.191/- – Tk.245/-.

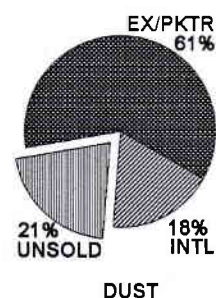
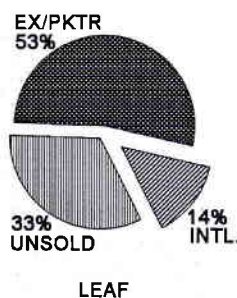
DUST: 10,063 packages were offered for sale. There was a fairly strong demand for the cleaner good liquoring lines at mostly firm to dearer rates. Plainer lines were often withdrawn without registering any bids.

SUPPLEMENTS+E-AUCTION: 2,985 packages were on offer. 39% sold and 61% remained unsold.

COMMENTS: Improved demand led to a firm to dearer market. Prices for the better teas inclined by Tk.3/5 and the mediums by Tk.1/2. Northern teas also gained. Dust prices were dearer for the cleaner types. Lower types were ignored. Packeteers operated with an improved strength. Local traders were fairly active.
